

BC 19: MEMORY VERSES

Below are the memory verses players need to know for this year's Bible Challenge. Remember, bible verses must be recited in the New International Version (NIV) for English or in La Nueva Version Internacional (NVI) for Spanish. Students do not have to memorize the verses in both languages. For your convenience, the verses have been provided below in English with the reference in Spanish.

The verses that are underlined need to be memorized for all regional tournaments—a total of 12 passages. The verses that are NOT underlined will be additional verses teams need to know for the championship—a total of 12 additional passages. Teams that move forward to the championship will be required to know all verses.

1) *Main Verse* Romans/Romanos 1:16

16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.

2) Romans/Romanos 2:11

11 For God does not show favoritism.

3) Romans/Romanos 3:23

23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

4) Romans/Romanos 4:3

3 What does Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness."

5) Romans/Romanos 5:6

6 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.

6) Romans/Romanos 5:8

8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

7) Romans/Romanos 5:12

12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned—

8) Romans/Romanos 6:22-23

22 But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. **23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

9) Romans/Romanos 7:15

5 I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do.

10) Romans/Romanos 7:22-25

22 For in my inner being I delight in God's law; **23** but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. **24** What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? **25** Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

11) Romans/Romanos 8:38-39

38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, **39** neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

12) Romans/Romanos 8:16-17

16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. **17** Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

13) Romans/Romanos 8:32

32 He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

14) Romans/Romanos 9:28

28 For the Lord will carry out his sentence on earth with speed and finality.”

15) Romans/Romanos 10:4

4 Christ is the culmination of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.

16) Romans/Romanos 10:9

9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

17) Romans/Romanos 10:14-15

14 How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? **15** And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

18) Romans/Romanos 11:5-6

5 So too, at the present time there is a remnant chosen by grace. **6** And if by grace, then it cannot be based on works; if it were, grace would no longer be grace.

19) Romans/Romanos 11:18

18 do not consider yourself to be superior to those other branches. If you do, consider this: You do not support the root, but the root supports you.

20) Romans/Romanos 11:36

36 For from him and through him and for him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen.

21) Romans/Romanos 12:2

2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

22) Romans/Romanos 12:4-5

4 For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, **5** so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

23) Romans/Romanos 12:9

9 Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.

24) Romans/Romanos 12:14

14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.

25) Romans/Romanos 13:1

1 Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God.

26) Romans/Romanos 13:9-10

9 The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not covet, and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." **10** Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.

27) Romans/Romanos 14:8

8 If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord.

28) Romans/Romanos 15:1-2

1 We who are strong ought to bear with the failings of the weak and not to please ourselves. **2** Each of us should please our neighbors for their good, to build them up.

29) Romans/Romanos 15:7

7 Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God

30) Romans/Romanos 16:20

20 The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.
